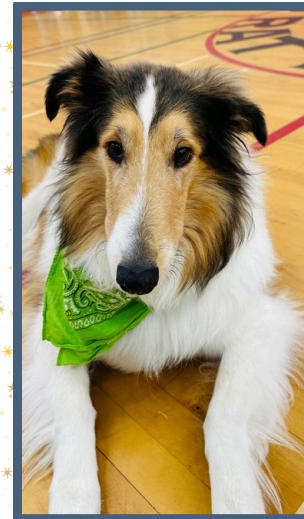

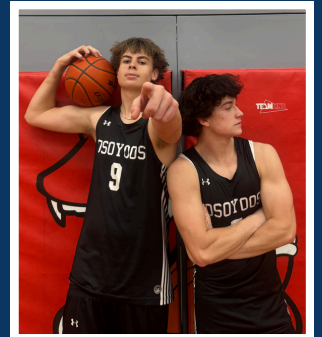

Students in Grades 10, 11 & 12 that would like to get a jump start on their post-secondary education.

How it helps?

Students have the opportunity to:

- Earn high school credits and post-secondary credentials at the same time
- Get a head start on learning and training for their future careers.
